CONDITIONS OF PERMIT:

- Fire must be attended by a competent person eighteen (18) years of age or older who must remain in attendance at the fire until it is completely extinguished.
- Initial burning will be allowed between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. but no combustible material shall be added to the fire after 3:00 p.m. unless authorized by the fire inspector.
- Adequate fire protection equipment including a charged hose and a shovel or rake must be on site.
- Burning of materials that produce heavy dense smoke shall not be burned. Such items include, but are not limited to, tires, tar paper, asphalt, salt treated wood, shingles and synthetic materials.
- Burning shall not occur if winds are high or if a ban is in effect.
- The Fire Department, the Police Department or the fire inspector is authorized to order burning to stop if, in their judgment, burning constitutes a hazard.
- This permit must be posted within ten (10) feet of the street during the period of the burn and removed after the fire is extinguished.
- Permit is valid only on the date(s) indicated above.

The applicant hereby acknowledges by signing below that he has read this permit and understands the fact that issuance of a permit in no way relieves the applicant from responsibility for any damage resulting from the burning activity or from prosecution for violation of a prohibition on burning and that permission is hereby granted to the fire inspector to access the property at reasonable times in order to conduct fire inspections.
