Day Light Savings, Set Clocks Forward on March 8

Daylight savings time begins on the second Sunday in March and ends on the first Sunday in November. On the second Sunday in March, clocks are set ahead one hour at 2:00 a.m. local standard time, which becomes 3:00 a.m. local daylight time. It is also a good time to change your smoke detector batteries.
