A Special Town Council Meeting is being held on Monday, March 23, 2009 at 7:00 P.M. in the Pitts Center. There will be one business item before the main agenda item which is to introduce and present to the citizens an educational format outlining how the FY 2009 – 2010 budget is being prepared. In consideration of the state of the economy, the budget is being developed earlier than has been past practice. This is the time and opportunity for the citizens to provide their input and have their voice heard. Citizen feedback forms will be provided to further facilitate the Town's ability to obtain citizen input for use as the budget process proceeds towards finalization.
