Several citizens of Southern Shores would like to start a home-delivered meal route in the Southern Shores area. Merrie Smith, Town of Southern Shores Executive Assistant, volunteered to serve as the area coordinator and is the primary point of contact. Merrie recently contacted Darlene Harrell, Nutrition Program Director, offering Southern Shores Town Hall as a meal drop-off and distribution facility.

The Albemarle Commission Senior Nutrition Home Delivered Meals Program delivers meals to homebound seniors over sixty years of age who are unable to prepare their own meals. This program is need-based and not related to income. There is an un-met need for this service in the Southern Shores area that is not being served by existing routes in Dare County.

Merrie enjoys the full support of her colleagues and the Town's leadership with this project. Let's all help Merrie succeed with this generous and worthy program. Please call Merrie if you or someone you know needs this service. After she determines the needs of the community, Merrie will call for volunteers to start the new route and deliver the meals. We will need a solid group of people willing to dedicate their time to their neighbors. It takes a lot of effort to get the home-delivered meals started in a new part of the county. Meals are delivered to the drop-off site (Town Hall) by a caterer pre-packaged in individual temperature-controlled carriers ready for distribution.
