## **Reminder \*\*Transportation Community Input**

Monday, April 6<sup>th</sup>, 7:00PM in the Pitts Center, the Planning Advisory Group and Town Engineer will provide an informative and educational presentation about traffic related strategies and to address transportation issues. Included in this information will be a description of a developing ordinance on traffic cut-through along with a presentation by Joe Anlauf from Quible & Associates on creative street adjustments that enhance town aesthetics as well as improve traffic flow. These presentations are being made to provide citizens and property owners with information and to solicit their input and feedback relating to these important matters.

## **Town Project updates**

Juniper Trail Multi-purpose Path, Phase 2 will be starting construction today. This is extending the multi-use path to the East Carolina Bank.

Hickory Trail: Next week (April 6-10) RPC intends to "pop" the tree stumps and will begin milling the road the following week (April 13-17). They do not intend to "shut down" the road when they pull stumps but will when they begin to mill. "Shut Down" means they will be setting

up traffic control measures and beginning to restrict traffic to local/residential. We will keep everyone up to date on these projects.

## **Town Council Meeting and Mayor's Chat, April 7th**

At 6 PM is the Mayor's Chat, a time to discuss with the Mayor any of your concerns in an informal setting. At 7 PM is the Town Council meeting that will include a conditional use hearing on Sandy Ridge Shopping Center for a Pizza Restaurant. For more information on the meeting go to [Agenda](#).
