- There will be shuttle service for anyone requiring a ride to Town Hall on Saturday, April 18th. You are encouraged to walk or bike, show everyone how fit and green we are in Southern Shores. There will be no parking at the Town Hall complex. Please park at the south end of the Market Place next to the Bank of Currituck. The bus will pickup/drop-off and park at Southern Shores Crossing where street-legal golf carts will shuttle you back and forth to Town Hall. *Parking on Skyline Rd. is reserved for the vendors.
- Make sure you visit the 23 art and crafters located under the Tent and inside the Pitts Center.
- Also visit the exhibits in the Pitts Center. There will be a wide variety of businesses and services available to the property owners in Southern Shores.
- Entertainment, food, and refreshments begin at 12 noon.
