CANAL MAINTENANCE DREDGING UPDATE

GOOD NEWS! This afternoon the Town reached an agreement with the Stone family for the use of their commercial property location as a spoils dewatering site. This means we can move ahead with the next step of securing our dredging permit from the State. Many thanks to the Stone family for their cooperation and support in making this happen.

In addition, the Town was also successful in receiving a one year extension to the NCDENR State Grant, which means we will have grant money available for dredging this year.

Next step in the process will be the development of the engineering plans and putting the job out for bid. We will keep you informed as this moves along.
