DO NOT PLACE ANY BRUSH OUT. ****NO SCHEDULED CHIPPING IN JUNE, JULY, or AUGUST****. Persons placing their brush out for chipping during this time frame will be required to remove it from the Town's Right-of-Way. *Failure to do so will result in the Town bringing in the chipper for an unbudgeted service and the offender will be billed directly by the service provider at the prevailing rate of \$180 per hour for that service.
