Day Light Savings, Set Clocks Forward on March 14

Daylight savings time begins on the second Sunday in March and ends on the first Sunday in November. On Sunday March 14th, clocks are set ahead one hour at 2:00 a.m. local standard time, which becomes 3:00 a.m. local daylight time. It is also a good time to change your smoke detector batteries.
