From the Canal Dredge Project Manager – Update

Our contractor continues to move forward in their ongoing effort to resolve the default. We are hopeful they will present a proposal to the Town within two weeks, which Council will find acceptable.

The Boat Club continues their work at the North Marina. We still have a few marker numbers and lights to install on the day markers but the channel is navigable.

There have been a number of inquiries about the silt fence-the plan is to remove it the week of April 19th. We are required to have the turf established prior to removal. We did remove a portion of it just north of the ramp (the turf there had not been as severely impacted) to give better access to the dock.

Just a couple of reminders, please be alert and watch your speed in transiting the channel-it is more narrow than you have been used to and may mean slowing down a bit.

I did a depth check this past week, on a day with normal water level, and found no water shallower than 4', staying center channel. That depth can vary a good bit depending on the wind direction, as we all know.

The parking space markers are scheduled for installation in the upper (trailer) parking lot during the first week in May. Until then, please park facing the east side of the parking lot, leaving room for other vehicles to pass behind your trailer.
