Build the Bridge, Preserve Our Roads

The BBPR gave Council a Mid-Currituck Bridge update and asked Council to support their recommendations to the NC Turnpike Authority. The NC Turnpike Authority will hold a Pre-Hearing Open House and Combined Corridor/Design Public Hearings to accept public comments. Two of these meetings will be held in Currituck (May 19 at the Outer Banks Center for Wildlife Education in Corolla and May 20 at the Currituck County Center in Barco). One of these meetings will be held in Dare County (May 18 at the Ramada Plaza in Kill Devil Hills). All pre-hearing open houses run from 3:30 – 6:30 PM, with the public hearing to follow at 7 PM. The public is urged to attend.

One Week Left for Early Primary Voting!!

There will be No-excuse early voting at the Dare County Board of Elections in Manteo and at the Baum Center, Kill Devil Hill, through April 30 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. For more information, call Dare County Board of Elections 475-5630. If you have not registered to vote you may do so at the early voting.

Registered voters affiliated with the Democratic Party may vote in the Democratic Primary; registered voters affiliated with the Republican Party may vote in the Republican Primary. Voters registered as unaffiliated may declare themselves either Democrat or Republican for this election only and vote in either Primary.

The primary election will be held May 4 for NC Senator, NC Representative, Judges; Superior Court and District Court, County Commissioners, Board of Education and Sheriff, Clerk of Court, Register of Deeds and the District Attorney. There will be **NO CHIPPING IN JUNE, JULY, AND AUGUST** - May is the last month of chipping until September. Your piles must be out before Monday morning of your
