### **Proposed FY 2010-11 Budget**

Town Manager's proposed operating budget for fiscal year July 1, 2010- June 30, 2011, has been presented to the Southern Shores Town Council. The proposed FY 2010-2011 Budget is \$5,896,650 with a tax rate of fourteen cents (0.14) per \$100 valuation of taxable property in the Town of Southern Shores, with three cents (.03) reserved for capital reserve fund for capital projects. ### **From the Canal Dredge Project Manager - Update**

The contractor continues negotiations for an alternate spoils dewatering/disposal site. We have been advised that the discussions are moving forward. There is reason to believe that an agreement is close at hand.

Depending on the outcome of these discussions, we could see the completion of the restoration of the North Marina site, including removal of the last of the silt fence and repaving a significant portion of the ramp access roadway. It may be necessary to close the ramp for a day or two during this process. You will be advised as plans develop.

The early June meeting with the regulatory agency representatives is still on schedule. The plan is to discuss the necessary permit modifications which will allow us to re-start the phase one dredge. We also hope to receive some input on the requirements necessary to secure a permit for the balance of our dredge project.
