From the Canal Dredge Project Manager - Update

At their workshop on Tuesday, Town Council received a comprehensive briefing from the prospective dredge contractor. The briefing included a detailed explanation of the dredge method to be used, the techniques to be employed and the proposed site utilization.

The next step in this process is the submission of our permit modification request which should take place within the next few days.

Main Channel Revisited

After a discussion with members of the boat club and Coast Guard Auxiliary, a decision has been made to reduce speed in the Ginguite Channel, especially when boats are passing. To that end, signs will be placed in the North Marina and at the junction marker. The signs will emphasize the need for moderate speed, "No Wake" when passing. In addition, emails will be sent to members of the Southern Shores Boat Club and to the Martins Point Boaters advising them of this change.

It should also be noted that there are some shallow stretches - particularly, from markers 14 to 10 and markers 8 to 4.
