From the Canal Dredge Project Manager - Update

An important meeting was held this week with the point person from the Division of Coastal Management. The Town Engineer and permit coordinator explained our process in some detail, answered specific questions regarding our planned approach and made a few changes to clarify our drawings. This process will be beneficial to us in moving our permit modification request more quickly through the various regulatory agencies who must review and/or approve our plan.

Based on this discussion, we believe we should be able to begin the mobilization efforts in early September and actually start to dredge in early October. Assuming things do fall into place for us, the phase one canals will be closed to boat traffic much earlier than last year. Our prospective contractor plans to dredge the interior portions first, then move to the Ginguite Channel to finish. It is too early to forecast an exact schedule, but you will be kept advised well in advance of the actual installation of pipe or closing of the various sections of canal.
