Seeds cut from your own garden gone to seed:

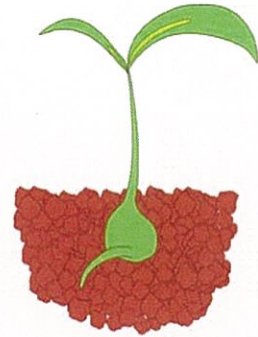
zinnias, marigolds, gaillardia, any kind of daisy or coreopsis .

Small cuttings of blooming shrubs like oleander or tough retaining plants
like lirioppe, would be welcome and would make a difference.

Drop seed packets at any Ace Hardware collection box
with the name of the plant in felt tip pin on it.

Give packets to your local Master Gardener Association
Winter veggie seeds will be used in Community Garden
and the crops donated to their Food Pantry.

In early March, the seeds will be made available,
free to residents from Rodanthe to Avon at local firestations
