

- The authority to provide public services: police, fire, solid waste, etc.
- Rules related to streets and traffic
- Rules of conduct for residents and visitors
- The zoning code

## WHAT IS THE CAMA LAND USE PLAN?

- Coastal Area Management Act (CAMA)
- Purpose: protect sensitive coastal lands
- Emphasis on how much growth an area can sustain
- Requires land use plan with minimum requirements



#### VISION

#### LAND USE & DEVELOPMENT GOALS

- 1. Private access facilities to public waters and shorelines
- Compatibility with surroundings and maintain community character
- 3. Balance infrastructure with environment
- Protect natural environment and water quality
- 5. Mitigate natural hazards

#### KEY POLICY GUIDANCE

- 1. No new commercial development
- 2. No new multi-family residential development
- 3. Maintain community character
- 4. Protect the coastal environment
- 5. Protect public health and safety
