




#### **Traffic Violation Citations & Warnings**







Officer Tracy Mann was awarded the position of school resource officer for Kitty Hawk Elementary School.






Sergeants Jon Slegel and Brad Eilert were recognized at a town council meeting for their promotions to Lieutenant and First Sergeant, respectively.





Officer Matt Cooke was recognized at a town council meeting for his promotion to Sergeant.


