Hey Wes,

Probably be a good idea to also include this concept that came out of our discussion with builders last week in the PB members info. I added a minor concern of Elizabeth's and tagged a sentence on the end as well from Matt's language.

Maximum building height shall be 35 feet, measured from the average of the existing, undisturbed grade at the building corners. If the average of the existing, undisturbed grade at the building corners is less than 8 feet above mean sea level, the maximum building height may be measured from 8 feet above mean sea level, provided that the horizontal-to-vertical slope criteria can be attained.
