TRASH & RECYCLING -SCHEDULES & INFORMATION

Trash=Monday (Year-Round)

Recycling= Friday (Year-Round)

Trash- “In Season” Memorial Day to Labor Day = **Monday & Fri** (begins Fri. June 3, 2022)
(ends Mon. Sept. 5, 2022)

- Roll your collection cans out the night before – collection begins at 3:00 a.m. Receptacles should be placed in the street right-of-way not sooner than 24 hours prior to collection and should be moved out of the street right-of-way prior to midnight following each collection.
- Trash or recycling placed outside of or on top of the cans will not be collected.
- Residential receptacles shall have fully functional lids that cover the entire receptacle.
- Residential receptacles shall have fully functional wheels.
- Every residential receptacle should be labeled with a Town issued informational sticker (stickers can be obtained at Town Hall at no charge).

To Purchase new or Additional cans: Please call Bay Disposal at 252-491-5105 to purchase trash cans **and** recycling cans. Replacement parts may also be available (for Bay Disposal cans only). Payment is accepted over the phone.

New homeowner or renter? To begin service just place the can curbside the night before collection.

In the event your trash collection is missed please call Town Hall 252-261-2394. **All trash and recycling collection trucks are equipped with video monitoring equipment to record incidents of collection.**

Trash Guide: Trash cans purchased from Bay Disposal are dark grey. Old trash cans in black or solid dark green are acceptable and may still be used.

Trash must be inside can and the lid must be closed. The following cannot be placed into trash cans and will not be picked up: Oil, propane, paint, charcoal, yard waste, construction debris or hazardous waste.

Recycling Guide: Recycling cans purchased from Bay Disposal are green with a yellow lid. Old cans in red/burgundy or blue are acceptable and may still be used.

Recycling must be inside can and the lid must be closed. Place clean materials loose in the can (no bagging, tying or bundling). Corrugated boxes must be broken down/cut to fit inside the can.

Receptacle size and number: Residences: Each single residential unit shall have at least one of each town-approved solid waste receptacle and recycling receptacle. Residential units of four bedrooms or less offered for vacation rentals shall have at least three solid waste receptacles and two recycling receptacles. Residential units of five or more bedrooms offered for vacation rentals shall have at least five solid waste receptacles and three recycling receptacles.

Commercial establishments: The property owner or tenant is required to supply adequate receptacles to accommodate all materials generated at the site.

RECYCLING CENTER DROP-OFF POINT

The Town of Southern Shores does not have a drop off location for recycling for residents or visitors since the Town offers curbside recycling service. County Recycling Center locations and information can be found at www.darenc.com/departments/public-works/recycling. There is also a recycling drop off center in Kitty Hawk that is managed by Dare County where certain types of recyclables may be taken at no charge (bulk items do require a \$50 permit - Please Note: electronics, appliances and tv's do not require a permit.). Information on this center follows.

MATERIALS ACCEPTED: Normal household recyclables may be taken at no charge. Please see flyer or town website for a complete list of accepted items. **PLEASE NOTE:** The Kitty Hawk/Dare County Center site attendant will reject anything other than the household recyclable items listed.

MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTED:

- Brush, Leaves & Lawn Clippings: may be taken at no charge to the [Dare Co. Public Works Recycling](#) facility located in Manteo at 1018 Driftwood Drive phone 252-475-5880
- Chemicals: Contact manufacturer
- Commercial Debris: may be taken to the [Dare County C&D Landfill](#) located at 1603 Cub Road, Manns Harbor, NC 27953, phone 252-473-2059
- Hazardous Materials: Follow manufacturers label recommendations
- Hot Tubs & Covers: may be taken at no charge to the [Dare Co. Landfill](#)
- Mattresses: may be taken at no charge to the Dare Co. Landfill
- Paint: Dry out and dispose in regular household garbage
- Regular Household Garbage: may be taken at no charge to the Dare Co. Landfill
- Shingles: may be taken to the Dare Co. Landfill
- Styrofoam: Dispose in regular household garbage

BULK & CONSTRUCTION/DEMOLITION DEBRIS - self generated (not contractor-generated):

Option 1: The [Kitty Hawk/Dare County Recycling Center](#) accepts old furniture, minor residential debris, self-generated (not contractor-generated) construction and demolition debris, and other large items from residents of Southern Shores. Please see flyer or town website for a complete list of accepted items. **PLEASE NOTE:** The Kitty Hawk/Dare County Center site attendant will reject anything other than the household recyclable items listed. The cost to Southern Shores property owners is \$50 per half-pick up load – permit valid for one-time use. The [Kitty Hawk/Dare County Recycling Center](#) permit must be purchased from Southern Shores Town Hall beforehand. Please Note: electronics, appliances and tv's do not require a permit. If over a half-pick up load it will be rejected and will need to go to the [Dare County C&D Landfill](#), usually at no charge, at 1603 Cub Road, Manns Harbor, NC 27953, phone 252-473-2059.

Option 2: [Dare County C&D Landfill](#), usually at no charge, at 1603 Cub Road, Manns Harbor, NC 27953, phone 252-473-2059.

Glass: brown, green, clear, bottles and jars. Porcelain, ceramic, plates, mirrors, windows (glass only), crystal, bake ware. **No light bulbs, or window frames!** **Preparation:** rinse, remove lids. No need to separate colors.

Plastics: #1 bottles soda, water and juice. Remove lids, rinse. Put into bins marked with plastic. **NO HOT TUBS, plates, cups, STYROFOAM or Motor oil bottles.**

Preparation: rinse, remove lids.

Plastics: #2 bottles and jugs, translucent milk, water and tea jugs. Remove lids, rinse. Put into bins marked with plastics. **NO HOT TUBS, plates, cups, STYROFOAM** of any kind, buckets, or toys.

Preparation: rinse, remove lids.

Plastics: #2 - #7 bottles and jugs, colored Laundry soap containers, toiletries containers, etc. Remove lids, rinse. Put into bins marked with plastics. **NO HOT TUBS, plates, cups, STYROFOAM** of any kind.

Preparation: rinse, remove lids.

Batteries: Lead-acid automotive, marine, mower and all other vehicle and rechargeable batteries, and single use battery.

Paper Bin: Newspaper, copy paper, mail, food boxes, shoeboxes, magazines, catalogs, phone books, paper bags. **No plastic bags, paper that is wet, contaminated with food or dirt such as pizza boxes!!!!**

Cardboard bin: Corrugated cardboard only. Must be dry, flattened and all packing materials must be removed. **No waxed, wet or dirty boxes allowed. No styrofoam.**

Used motor oil: From Residential sources only. Don't forget to bring you used oil filter! Maximum 5 gallons per visit. **NO mixtures of motor oil and water, solvents, gasoline, paint products, flammable liquids, brake fluid or any hazardous materials.**

Cooking Oil: From Residential sources only.

Anti-Freeze/Coolant: From Residential sources only.

Aluminum cans: beverage only, no pet food cans. Place in bin marked aluminum cans. Crushing is optional.

Steel cans: including pet food cans. Must be rinsed, label may stay on and placed into steel cans bin.

Scrap metals and appliances: stoves, washers, water heaters, air conditioners, refrigerators, pipe, siding, tools, lawn mowers, etc. **NO, auto gas tanks or oil reservoirs.** DO NOT crush appliances that contain Freon; drain all fluid reservoirs and tanks.

Waste Gasoline and 2-cycle gas from residential sources only. Maximum 5 gallons per visit. Do not place in oil tanks. Please see attendant for assistance.

Electronics: All electronic devices and computer monitors.

Small Propane Tanks the ones typically used with outdoor grills. **NO large household heating tanks.** PLEASE CALL THE GAS COMPANY LISTED ON THE TANK FOR LARGE TANKS.

Bulky items, *****FROM KITTY HAWK RESIDENTS ONLY, NO Fee ***self-generated (not contractor-generated) construction and demolition debris.** construction and demolition debris, Furniture, lumber, siding, junk, glass, carpet, TV's, etc. **No mattresses, box springs, hot tubs or hot tub covers! These items must be taken to the Dare County C & D landfill.** *****Residents of Southern Shores see permit and fee information below:**

The Recycling Center also accepts old furniture, minor residential debris, **self-generated (not contractor-generated) construction and demolition debris**, and other large items from residents of Southern Shores. **The cost to Southern Shores property owners is \$50 per half-pick up load (over a half-pick up load will be rejected and will need to go to the Dare County landfill)– permit valid for one-time use. The permit must be purchased from Southern Shores Town Hall beforehand.** Please note that electronics, appliances and tv's do not require a permit.

Pallets: 3 per visit

Shingles: NONE

Concrete/Asphalt/Brick: 1 wheelbarrow load per month!

NO commercially generated C & D or bulky waste items. These must be taken to the Dare County C & D landfill located at 1603 Cub Road, Manns Harbor, NC Phone: 252-473-2059

Tires: Tires must be off the rim. From Residential sources only. Maximum 4 tires per visit.

Shells: Oysters, clams, and mussels. Place in yellow bin marked as such.

Brush, leaves, and lawn clippings: **Lawn clippings and brush** must be disposed at the Dare County Public Works facility located at 1018 Driftwood Drive, in Manteo

Many thrift shops in Dare County will accept gently used household items or clothes. Please call them for details.

SEMI-ANNUAL BULK WASTE COLLECTION

The Town of Southern Shores schedules two (2) bulk waste collections each year. One in the spring (April) and one in the fall (October). Dates to be announced.

The next scheduled bulk waste collection will be:

~announced a few weeks prior to the event: on the Town website, Town Bi-monthly Newsletter, and the Coastland Times newspaper~

Approved items should be ready for pick-up no later than 5:00 a.m. on the scheduled bulk waste collection day.

Approved Bulk waste CAN include large items such as:

- **Mattresses, Sofas, Chairs, Dressers, Furniture, etc.**
- **Exercise Equipment**
- **Hot Tub Covers (NO Hot Tubs)**
- **Refrigerators, freezers or any other appliances** that may contain refrigerant must be tagged stating Freon has been removed (if not tagged it will not be collected) *please remove doors from refrigerators/freezers for safety
- **Yard waste/vegetative debris** bagged in clear or brown paper bags – otherwise it will be rejected and not picked up

These materials NOT approved for collection:

REJECTED ITEMS will have a visible X painted on them.

- **Televisions:** may be taken at no charge to [Kitty Hawk/Dare County Recycling Center](#) or [Dare County C&D Landfill](#)
- **Hot Tubs:** may be taken at no charge to Dare County C&D Landfill
- **Water Heaters:** may be taken at no charge to Kitty Hawk/Dare County Recycling Center or Dare County C&D Landfill
- **Basketball Goal Posts:** may be taken, with a \$50 permit, to [Kitty Hawk/Dare County Recycling Center](#) or at no charge to [Dare County C&D Landfill](#)
- **Untagged refrigerators or any appliances containing a refrigerant:** may be taken at no charge to Kitty Hawk/Dare County Recycling Center or Dare County C&D Landfill
- **Hazardous materials such as Paints, Solvents, Chemicals, etc.:** follow manufacturers label recommendations
- **NO Building materials. NO Lumber, Scrap Lumber, Roofing, Doors, Screens, Windows, Stairs, Carpet, Rugs, Cabinets, Toilets, Pallets or Demolition debris:** may be taken, with a \$50 permit, to [Kitty Hawk/Dare County Recycling Center](#) or at no charge to [Dare County C&D Landfill](#)
- **Soil, Rocks, Concrete, and Stumps:** may be taken at no charge to Dare County C&D Landfill
- **Tires, any item(s) containing Gasoline:** Tires must be off the rim. From Residential sources only. Maximum 4 tires per visit – may be taken at no charge to Kitty Hawk/Dare County Recycling Center
- **NO items produced as a result of a contracted service or business**

*Please do not place items for the large item pickup at the roadside until one week before your pickup will be held. If the contractor does not take an item(s) you placed on the roadside, it has been rejected and must be disposed of at your expense. Take pride in your home and respect your neighbors. Please do not leave trash at the roadside expecting it to be picked up.

*Please note that the entire town is picked up in one day. This requires the contractor to work into the very late evening. Please do not call Town Hall the day of pickup about missed pick-up inquires as the contractor is most likely still completing pickup. If a pickup is missed please call the day after scheduled pickup for assistance.

BULK WASTE SPECIAL PICKUP
