Government Education Access Channels Committee
2017-2018 Proposed Budget

The following items are presented to the Town of Southern Shores Town Council for their review and approval.

Specific Action Requested:

Approve the proposed 2017-2018 Budget

Budget Summary

The Government Education Access Channels (GEAC) Committee has reviewed and approved the proposed 2017-2018 budget for the operation of the Government and Education Channel. The proposed budget, which would take effect July 1, 2017, must be approved by every participating member entity of the Channels, which includes the towns of Duck, Southern Shores, Kitty Hawk, Kill Devil Hills, Nags Head, Manteo, and Dare County, Dare County Schools, College of The Albemarle, and UNC Coastal Studies Institute.

The budget as proposed requires no additional funding from the participating entities above the current annual \$1000 membership fee. Our budget is funded mainly from the North Carolina Video Distribution proceeds, which are disbursed quarterly by the State to certified members of the GEAC. These funds must be used for the operations of the two channels and no other purpose. Additionally, the legislation that originally established the Video Distribution funding required that the proceeds not supplant current funding. Accordingly, the annual \$1000 membership fee that was in place when the program began must remain, or the Channels would lose all Video Distribution funding from the State.

The GEAC committee recommends the budget, which includes, in part, the following: funding for two full-time staff positions and a Local Programming Development Initiative to assist members in the development of programming for the Government and Education Channels. The funding also includes the continued funding of two regular news magazine shows that highlight each of the participating members of the GEAC on the Education Channel and the Government Channel.

Executive Summary

Funding comes from the state of North Carolina use tax on cable and satellite fees. Our revenue from this source in 2017-2018 is projected to be \$275,862.00. In addition, each of the 10 entities pay a \$1000 membership fee annually to participate in the channel's operations. This \$1000 fee is unchanged and is the only impact on each entity's budget. This money that is received from the entities in support of the Government and Education Access Channels must remain in the budget in order for each entity to continue to receive PEG Supplements from the state of North Carolina. This budget is requesting a total of \$91,175.00 be allocated from the fund balance. The fund balance is projected to be \$318,084.39 on June 30, 2017. The proposed total budget for the Government and Education Access Channels Committee for 2017-2018 is \$378,037.00.

**Government and Education Access Channel
Proposed Budget Notes for 2017-2018**

Goals and Objectives to be achieved with this budget.

1. Continue to fund the operation of the channel at a level that provides a professional, reliable and quality service to the citizens of Dare County.
2. Continue to bring the fund balance down to an appropriate level and strategically use the fund balance to fund channel initiatives.

¹ Member Fees - Each entity member pays an annual membership fee to participate in the Government and Education Channel Access. This money must remain in place in order for each entity to receive the PEG Supplement from the state. **There is no change to this amount from last year, so impact on each entity's budget is unchanged..**

² NC PEG Supplemental Video Disbursement - this is revenue that is collected by the state in the form of a use tax on cable and satellite providers. The money is pooled and disbursed to qualifying PEG operations within the state. PEG stands for Public, Education, and Government Access. Dare County has 10 qualifying PEG entities, each is a member of the Government and Education Access Channel Committee. Each quarter, this money is disbursed to the entities by the state, and then the Government and Education Access Channels invoices the entities for this money. These state funds are the main source of funding for the Government and Education Access Channels.

³ Interest Income - This is interest the Government and Education Access Channels Committee receives on the fund balance.

⁴ Appropriated Fund Balance - The unappropriated fund balance is projected to be \$318,084 on June 30, 2017. The appropriated fund balance is the amount pulled from the unappropriated fund balance to meet the obligations of the budget.

⁵ Salaries - This budget currently funds two full-time positions that are considered to be Dare County employees.

⁶ Contractual Services - This is for the production of Destination Dare and Dare Education Awareness, our two main programming initiatives that highlight interesting aspects of government and education in Dare County. Each entity contributes one segment to each episode. Destination Dare is produced every other month, and Dare Education Awareness is produced on the alternate months.

⁷ Channel Operations (Maintenance and Technical Support of Playout Server) - This budget item is the annual maintenance and technical support for the master control automation and playout server that feeds the channels.

⁸ Streaming Video/VOD Reflect - As part of the playout server upgrade, we are providing a more effective streaming capability of our signal online, and, in addition, provide a video on demand service

that will be much better than our current YouTube channel. This is the annual subscription to support that service.

⁹ Supplies - This the purchase supports supplies such as batteries, gaffers tape, lighting gels, accessories, and small equipment items that do not qualify as Capital Outlay.

¹⁰ Marketing Plan - This will support the implementation of a professional marketing effort to allow us to better use outreach tools to bring viewers to our channel and to help identify what kinds of information viewers want to see when they watch our channel.

¹¹ Capital Outlay - This is money to upgrade our playout server to better meet the needs of our audience.

¹² Professional Memberships - This supports memberships for the two staff positions for the Southeastern Association of Telecommunications Officers and Advisors (SEATOA), National Association of Telecommunications Officers and Advisors (NATOA), and The North Carolina City and County Communicators (NC3C). These are national, regional and state professional associations for PEG Channel Operators.

¹³ Contingency - This is for expenses that come up that were either unplanned or unforeseen. Not for use of everyday expenses.

¹⁴ Emergency Contingency - This pays for storm related overtime for the hourly employee during Emergency Management Activations.

Dear Members of the Town Council,


Approximately one year ago, I began discussions with the Town staff about the Fire Department's need for an updated facility and what options we could explore to make it happen. Possible financing and site location options were all discussed with Town staff several times. Over the following months, I presented the content of those discussions at several committee meetings for further discussion with your members. I subsequently began to brief you, as a Council, last summer and informed you that the Fire Department had funded a facility needs assessment to be conducted by a reputable architectural firm experienced in designing institutional buildings, especially for municipal fire departments in eastern North Carolina. Based on that completed study, it is evident the Southern Shores Volunteer Fire Department needs a modernized and up to date facility if it is going to keep meeting the fire protection needs of the Town of Southern Shores. A modern facility would aid in maintaining the volunteer staff and is needed to protect the safety of our membership. As I have stated many times before, safety is my number one priority as Chief. I take our members health and safety very personally and consider them as part of my own family. The volunteer system is, without a doubt, the most cost effective way to provide emergency services for the town. It is my belief that we, as leaders in the community, must do everything in our power to preserve and cultivate an environment that will perpetuate the volunteer system. As Chief, it is my responsibility to provide the Southern Shores Volunteer Fire Department Board of Directors and our customers with the information necessary make sure the department is prepared to provide the best service possible for our community 10, 20, 30 years in to the future. If for any reason we were unable to continue with the volunteers and had to hire a staff, the station must be able to accommodate that staff. Currently, we would be unable to do this. I understand this is a decision that should not be taken lightly, however, I believe in my heart this is absolutely the right thing to do for the Town of Southern Shores and its residents.

The Southern Shores Volunteer Fire Department has now made a formal request to you as a Town Council to consider committing financial support for a modern fire station, serving the Town's fire protection needs. Site location, layouts, and basic size options have been investigated and presented to you. In order to proceed, the Fire Department needs a commitment from the Town Council to support this initiative financially. The next step is for the architect to complete the Schematic Design


Phase which takes the project through rendering drawings. The public will be included in this process in order to select an acceptable and appropriate design for a modern building. The Southern Shores Volunteer Fire Department has already funded the first portion of the Schematic Design Phase in the amount of \$17,000 for the complete facility assessment and needs study. Approximately \$40,000 more is needed to complete the Schematic Design Phase. In order to commence the remainder of that phase, the architect would need to know the cost and size the Town Council is willing to build.

There is no higher calling than serving the public, be it as Fire Chief, Police Chief or in your role as members of Council. Ensuring the safety and security of our citizens is a job that we must take very seriously; it must be our highest priority. Public safety has always been my passion; I hold myself and our crew to the highest standard possible and would not be asking you to consider this request unless I truly believed it was absolutely necessary. As you as individuals consider this prior to you March 7th meeting, please do not hesitate to contact me at any time to discuss any aspect of the Fire Department's request to the Council.

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St. James Fire Department will add substation at Seaside on land donated by developer

With an additional three acres to work with, courtesy of the St. James Plantation developer, the St. James Fire Department has established a timeline that could have a substation operating in the Seaside area with a new pumper truck and ambulance by spring 2018.

Department board president John Young, fire chief John Dahill and treasurer Jim Gear met with St. James Town Council at its Thursday workshop to discuss funding for the project. Previously, Young had met with town administrator Gary Brown and council members Wayne Deutscher and Don Lund to review the town's funding capacity to assist the fire department with its capital needs.

The new substation will be constructed at an estimated cost of \$1.4-million and will house a pumper truck (\$500,000) and ambulance (\$200,000). The \$2.1-million total expense will be offset by an "up-front" payment of \$750,000, "utilizing the existing balance in the town's Fire Department Reserve Fund, reallocating the level of funding for the Capital Reserve accounts for one year, and by deducting most of the compensation from the land acquisition" (by the N.C. Department of Transportation for N.C. 211 right-of-way), according to a memorandum prepared for town council by Brown.

The estimated cost would thereby be lowered 36-percent, with the balance financed over a period of 11 years, according to the plan. Monthly payments of \$12,835 would have the ambulance paid for in five years, the pumper truck in seven years and the substation at the end of the term.

The department has issued a "request for proposals" for the design-build substation and anticipates a construction start this spring, according to the memorandum, with the expectation of occupying the building in spring 2018.

At the Thursday morning workshop, department board president Young noted that when the main fire station was constructed, 16 years ago, on St. James Drive it was central to the St. James Plantation development, but no more. Since then, development has expanded south of Polly Gully Creek and westward to Middleton Boulevard. The new neighborhoods "have just exploded," fire chief John Dahill observed, resulting in many residences being located beyond a preferred distance for fire coverage.

State inspectors, on whose information fire insurance rates are set, recommend that fire equipment be located within one and a half to two and a half miles (depending on the type equipment). The Seaside community, closest to Middleton, is three and a half miles distant, he noted.

The new substation, to be located on Oceanic Drive, will meet the state standard, and can quickly serve the area south of Polly Gully Creek via Middleton Boulevard and Maxwell Drive. Additionally, a mutual aid agreement with the nearby Oak Island Fire Department allows for that department to respond to structure fires in that area of St. James.

Chief Dahill said that with the new station will come a need for new volunteers. He said a "door-to-door" recruitment will be undertaken, and he anticipates a need for 10 to 15 new members for both fire and emergency medical services. "Fifteen and fifteen would give us a great operation," he noted.

The new 7,000-square-foot facility also will house an emergency operations center, made possible by donation of an additional three acres of land that will provide plenty of parking space.

"It's not going to be a barn," Dahill promised, referring to the developer's wish that the facility be made attractive in conformity with the neighborhood. There will be room for adding bunkrooms, should the department ever have paid firefighters and EMS personnel.

"We're building for the future," Dahill told town council.

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

Southern Shores Volunteer Fire Department (SSVFD) Background



History

- The Southern Shores Volunteer Fire Department incorporated in 1982, with the station located at 28 East Dogwood, currently known as the East Station.
 - In 1988 the Southern Shores South Station(across from KHES) was built on land donated by the Kitty Hawk Land Company. It was completed in 1989 and currently serves as the Department headquarters for operations.
- The Department has consistently improved since its incorporation. As of 2015, our current ISO rating is a Protection Class 3.



Customer Relationships

- SSVFD has two primary customers:
 - The Town of Southern Shores
 - SSVFD has supported Toss for 34 years since its inception in 1982.
 - Dare County – Martin's Point
 - SSVFD has supported Dare County for 32 years since January 13, 1984.
- Mutual Aid: Across various counties
 - Provides for the return of mutual aid in the event of an emergency with the district.(Seventh Avenue/Wax Myrtle)
 - Helps aid in the staffing challenges at times due to the volunteer nature of the business.



Members

- The department has 42 active members which is enough to service the Town
 - Full time Fire Chief – only paid firefighter
 - 2 part time administrative specialists
 - 26 males (62%) and 17 females (38%)
 - Average age of 48
- Recruiting for a volunteer system is becoming more challenging
 - Increased regulation by the government
 - More challenging training requirements
 - Economic reasons - two income house holds
 - Personal reasons - Family commitments
 - Demographic Changes in the Community
 - Less retirees
 - Inability to respond due to employment commitments





Services Provided

- The SSVFD call volume has increased by 43% since 2007 with an increasing share of those calls for Emergency Services vs. fire calls
 - 2016 - 647 (65% EMS) calls vs. 2007 - 439(60% EMS)
 - Now averaging 12 calls per week
 - There have been very few fully involved structure fires in Southern Shores and Martins Point because the SSVFD has been able to get to the scene and mitigate them
 - We are always prepared for the worst but hope for the best
- Our Department answers a wide range of calls
 - Structure fires, vehicle accidents, vehicle fires, brush fires, alarms, EMS calls, and service calls (anything and everything)
 - When people don't know what to do or who to call they call the fire department!
 - Unfortunately or fortunately with an aging population the service calls occur quite often



Key Challenges Facing the Department

1. Recruiting and maintaining a fully staffed, all-volunteer organization
2. Steadily rising call counts
3. Rising operational costs
4. Aging facilities that don't meet the needs of a modern fire department (space)
5. Maintaining the ***highest level of safety*** for our volunteer members

Plan to Address Our Challenges



- Development of a plan to address our needs with a focus on facilities
- Commissioned a “Needs Study”, completed by Stewart-Cooper-Newell from Gastonia, NC to clarify operational and engineering needs and identify mitigating solutions
- Work with Town/County officials, the citizens of Southern Shores and Martin's Point to understand our needs and challenges moving forward



Eastern Carolinas & VA Fire Stations






Facility Options

- It is impossible to fit a 15,411 SF facility on the existing lot so these options solve for that issue
- Option 1
 - 15,411 sf 2 story building (except apparatus bays). Requires annexation of current Public works parking area (approximately 20 feet of property)
 - \$300 - \$325/SF \$4.6 – 5.0M total
- Option 2
 - 15,411 sf 2 story building (entire building) providing more parking and training space. Requires annexation of current Public works parking area (approximately 20 feet of property)
 - \$300 - \$325/SF \$4.6 – 5.0M total
- Option 3
 - 15,411 sf 1 story building providing more parking/training space and lower construction cost. Requires annexation of entire current Public Works lot.
 - \$275 - \$300/SF \$4.2 – 4.6M total


SITE PLAN OPTION B- SOUTH

Dear Southern Shores Property Owner:

At its regular meeting of February 7, 2017, the Southern Shores Town Council authorized me to make contact with you and other nearby property owners. This regards the ongoing consideration of a possible Town project to sand nourish a portion of the public trust ocean beach to which your property has access. As you may know, acute erosion of the beach in the area of your property has resulted since summer 2016.

Recognizing the importance of the public trust ocean beach to all property owners and residents of the Town, as well as to the economy created by returning annual visitors to the beach, the Town Council has engaged a coastal engineering firm to design a beach nourishment project. The project would effectively be an extension of the adjacent Kitty Hawk Beach nourishment project slated to begin in May 2017. The engineering firm is also authorized to secure all necessary permits, and present Council with a projected cost before it makes a final decision on the project. The Town Council has also authorized the Town Attorney to begin the process of obtaining necessary easements from oceanfront property owners for the purpose of constructing and perpetually maintaining the beach nourishment. Presently, the conceptual project consists of nourishing 1,500 linear feet of ocean beach in Southern Shores, with extra linear distance to accommodate an appropriate taper as a function of the project. Currently, based on the same sand volumes designed and permitted for the Kitty Hawk project, the project cost is estimated at approximately \$1,000,000. At its regular meeting of February 6, 2017, the Dare County Board of Commissioners voted to allow the Town of Southern Shores up to \$500,000 from the Dare County Beach Nourishment Fund to cover a portion of the project cost.

In order to be able to fully deliberate on a final decision, the Town Council has authorized me to communicate to each property owner in the project area the requirements of the special assessment process in order that the owners share in the project cost. Specifically, I am authorized to present to each property owner the opportunity of signing a petition to request a total assessment for all properties in the project area in the amount of \$150,000, divided proportionately per parcel size and spread over a five-year period. This amount represents 30% of the current approximate cost to the Town, considering up to \$500,000 of the cost would be covered by the County Fund.

The special assessment process may only start if a petition is received from a majority of the total property owners in the benefit area, and from a number of property owners representing 66% of the project area's assessed value. There are 26 separate parcels of land in the project area. A copy of a petition meeting the legal requirements to allow the special assessment process to commence is attached. The Town Council will need to receive a petition with the requisite number of owner signatures by its March 7, 2017 regular meeting. If the Council does subsequently decide to move forward with the project by incorporating special assessment revenues, those assessments would be collected annually over the next five years as a part of your property's tax billing.

TO THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHERN SHORES:

- A. We, the undersigned owners of parcels or real property located within an area which for purposes of this Petition, referred to as the “Southern Shores Beach Erosion Control Service District-South”, identified in Exhibit A (hereinafter “the Property”), do hereby petition the Town Council of the Town of Southern Shores, pursuant to Articles 10 and 10A of Chapter 160A of the North Carolina General Statutes, to undertake upon and/or for the benefit of the Property a capital project in the form of an engineered beach nourishment project along approximately 1,500 feet of public trust ocean beach at the southern-most end of the Town of Southern Shores town limits, including engineered placement of approximately 1,000 feet of sand to be tapered north of the 1,500 feet as a necessary function of the project (hereinafter, “the Project”), and to assess a portion of the cost of the Project against the Property as described in this Petition.
- B. We acknowledge the significant erosion occurring on the southern-most end of the public trust beach in the Town of Southern Shores. We believe this erosion is detrimental to the recreational, aesthetic, and economic enjoyment of the public trust beach by all citizens including the general public. We further believe the proposed Project will provide various substantial benefits to us as property owners and to the Town of Southern Shores and Dare County at large, including:
1. Protecting our property from additional water and storm damage, which increases with proximity to the ocean, and delaying the movement of our properties into the public trust ocean beach.
 2. Enhancing the existing public trust ocean beach for the benefit, use, and enjoyment of all citizens including the general public, thereby directly protecting the Town’s and County’s interest in income derived from a stabilized and increasing base of property values subject to taxation, as well as a stabilized and increasing tourism economy contributing directly to the revenues of the Town and the County through land transfer taxes, sales taxes, and occupancy taxes.
- C. It is the understanding of all the undersigned owners, that prior to the commencement of the Project it shall be necessary for all owners of the oceanfront properties within the Project area (including those within the taper area), to grant perpetual easements to the Town of Southern Shores, assignable to any other appropriate governmental entity participating in the Project now or in the future, for the construction and future maintenance of the Project or other beach nourishment projects on those portions of the oceanfront properties adjacent to and underlying the public trust ocean beach - as determined by the Town’s project engineer as necessary for the Project, future maintenance or other beach nourishment projects.
- D. It is our desire that the Project be implemented within the Project area and that the properties within the Southern Shores Beach Erosion Control Service District-South be assessed for the costs of the Project consistent with this Petition.

- E. **[Statement of the Project Proposed for Assessment]** - With respect to our specific property, we request:
1. That a certain cubic yard volume of beach-quality sand, determined by the Town's engineer to be sufficient for a nourishment project compatible with the adjacent nourishment project to occur in the Town of Kitty Hawk in summer 2017, be excavated from an ocean borrow site.
 2. That the excavated sand be deposited on the oceanfront portions of the Property, and specifically upon (i) portions of ocean front properties of the Property which may lie adjacent to the public trust ocean beach, as well as (ii) portions of ocean front properties of the Property underlying the public trust ocean beach, all being areas determined by the Town's project engineer to be necessary and sufficient to create a nourished beach and achieve all the public benefits intended by the Project described in this Petition.
 3. **[Estimate of Cost of the Project]** - Although the Town Council has not yet decided to undertake the Project, we understand the most current estimated total cost of the Project, including design engineering, construction, necessary legal costs, and necessary incidental costs including survey, monitoring, and public awareness initiative, has been estimated to be \$1,030,013.00. We also understand the cost of necessary replenishment of the beach at the end of the initial projected Project life of 5 years, has yet to be determined by the Town's project engineer; however as that amount may be subject to a future special assessment to cover the cost of necessary replenishment, we the undersigned do also hereby petition for such special assessment when necessary.
- F. We understand the Dare County Board of Commissioners ("Dare County"), in response to the Town of Southern Shores' request for assistance from the Dare County Beach Nourishment Fund, has agreed to reimburse the Town from the Fund an amount of 50% of the Town's total Project costs but no more than \$500,000 of such costs - excluding the cost of 5-year necessary beach re-nourishment which may also be the subject of a future request for Fund assistance.
- G. We understand that individual assessments for the cost, or a portion of the cost, of the Project may be imposed by the Town on properties according to an assessment method determined to most accurately assess each parcel of land within the Property according to the benefits conferred by the Project. As all parcels of land within the Property, notwithstanding front footage abutting on the Project, have direct legal access to the ocean beach being the Project area, we concur that the assessment method which will most accurately assess each parcel of land within the Property according to the benefit conferred upon it by the Project, is: the area of land served, or subject to being served, by the Project, at an equal rate per unit of area.
- H. **[Portion of the Cost of the Project Requested to be Assessed]** - We the undersigned owners of individual parcels of real property within the Property, petition to be assessed in accordance with the assessment method established by the Town, a total special assessment amount equal to 30% of the estimated total Project cost to the Town after reimbursement by Dare County from the Fund (said total cost to the Town currently estimated to be approximately \$500,000), and being approximately 15% of the total cost of the Project - excluding the cost of 5-year necessary beach re-nourishment which may also be the subject of a future request for Fund assistance.
- I. Pursuant to the assessment power of the Town of Southern Shores, established by Articles 10 and 10A of Chapter 160A of the North Carolina General Statutes, we hereby request and petition the Town Council to levy a special assessment against the Property benefited by the above Project.


WHEREAS, this Alternative MCB4 does not recommend any alterations to NC 12 through the Town of Southern Shores,


Whereas, the traffic congestion in Currituck and Dare counties caused by the lack of a Bridge is severely damaging the quality of life for communities in both counties; and,



RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHERN SHORES IN SUPPORT OF A MID-CURRITUCK BRIDGE AND OPPOSITION TO WIDENING NC 12

WHEREAS, the Currituck County beaches have become extremely popular and the traffic load heading there through mainland Currituck County, the NC 12 and US 158 intersection, the Towns of Kitty Hawk, Southern Shores and Duck continues to rapidly increase; and

WHEREAS, there is only one current access corridor to these beaches as described above;

WHEREAS, the current traffic counts taken by the NC Department of Transportation in 2001 indicate that the vast majority of the traffic load (70% on a summer weekend, 60% on a summer weekday and 66% on a non Summer weekday) using this route have a destination in the Currituck County Outer Banks; and

WHEREAS, construction of a Mid-Currituck Bridge would most significantly lessen this traffic load on the aforementioned roads, alleviate the current traffic back-up, save energy resources now consumed by traffic gridlock and provide an alternative route for both safety and hurricane evacuation; and

WHEREAS, the current DOT Currituck Sound Area Transportation Study (TIP Project R-2576) is examining alternatives to alleviate the current problem; and

WHEREAS, the focus of the current study effort is not directed at alleviating the current and growing problem primarily through the construction of the Mid-Currituck Bridge; and

WHEREAS, some focus has been placed upon widening NC 12 through the towns of Southern Shores and Duck to solve traffic problems with attendant destruction of the environment and character of both towns.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Town of Southern Shores Town Council once again reiterates that the construction of the Mid-Currituck Bridge as soon as possible is imperative for traffic, safety and public service reasons. Construction in 2009 as is presently planned is unacceptable.



WHEREAS, the only emergency evacuation route from the beaches of Currituck County is NC Route 12 which not only poses a serious safety problem for the residents and vacationers in that area but is also a complicating factor in an emergency evacuation of Dare County and the affected Towns in Dare County; and


WHEREAS, previously ordered evacuations have caused delays of up to four (4) hours to depart the northern beaches of Currituck County because there is only one way out.
