Ordinance 2016-12-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHERN SHORES, NORTH CAROLINA

ARTICLE I. Purpose(s) and Authority.

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.C.G.S. §§ 160A-301 and 302 the Town may regulate on and off-street parking;

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 160A-174 the Town may also enact and amend ordinances that define, prohibit, regulate, or abate acts, omissions, or conditions, detrimental to the health, safety, or welfare of its citizens and the peace and dignity of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town further finds that in accordance with the findings above it is in the interest of and not contrary to the public's health, safety, morals and general welfare for the Town to amend section 20-149 the Town's Parking Permit as stated below.

ARTICLE II. Construction.

For purposes of this ordinance amendment, underlined words (underline) shall be considered as additions to existing Town Code language and strikethrough words (~~strikethrough~~) shall be considered deletions to existing language. Any portions of the adopted Town Code which are not repeated herein, but are instead replaced by an ellipses ("...") shall remain as they currently exist within the Town Code.

ARTICLE III. Amendment of Sec. 20-149. - Parking permit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Southern Shores, North Carolina, that the Town Code shall be amended as follows:

Sec. 20-149. - Parking permit.

(a) As an exception to section 20-148, vehicles bearing current town parking permit stickers or hanging tags may park in designated town parking areas. This in no way modifies existing or future signs prohibiting parking completely or limiting parking in certain areas.

(b) When parking on shoulders, vehicles must not impede two-way traffic.

- (c) All efforts will be made to utilize grassy areas on the shoulders and not to destroy natural shrubbery.
- (d) Parking that blocks driveways, fire hydrants and intersections is strictly forbidden.


ARTICLE VI. Effective Date.


